

## **Student Services Specialist (3-5)**

**PURPOSE**: To provide direct intervention instruction to students and assist in developing a systematic school-wide approach to MTSS. Facilitates and coordinates the implementation of classroom intervention supports at all tiers. Provides direct curriculum and instructional support.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Illinois Professional Educator License (PEL) with LBS1 endorsement;
- 2. Experience working with special education students;
- 3. Ability to independently problem-solve, schedule daily activities, model positive and effective communication, and work effectively with professional staff and parents.

## PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Provide individual and small group instruction designed to meet individual needs and motivate students in pull out and/or classroom setting;
- 2. Support IEP process including delivery of specialized instruction;
- 3. Assist with designing intervention and monitoring response to intervention for students who are struggling;
- 4. Assist schools in developing strategic plans for intervention and growth for all students;
- 5. Monitor and report student achievement data associated with the multi-tier assessments;
- 6. Manage student intervention caseloads;
- 7. Mentor school-based Problem Solving teams through development and implementation of MTSS at all tiers:
- 8. Serve as a liaison to administrators, teachers, counselors, school social workers, school psychologists, and other stakeholders to develop appropriate positive behavior interventions and supports through MTSS:
- 9. Maintain records as required by the school, District and/or state and complete appropriate reports as directed;
- 10. Communicate and work closely with the regular classroom teachers while assisting in the development of each student's intervention program/IEP;
- 11. Utilize in-depth knowledge of data collection and progress monitoring;
- 12. Model lessons and strategies in the classroom;
- 13. Develop and provide materials for/with colleagues;
- 14. Be available to co-teach lessons;
- 15. Assume responsibility for continued professional growth;
- 16. Support Glenview 34 policy and Strategic Plan;
- 17. Other duties as assigned.
