Role: Paraprofessional is under the direct supervision of a General Education

or Special Education Teacher, Building Administrators and Assistant

Superintendent of Student Services.

Reports to: Building Principal in conjunction with the Assigned Teacher.

Employment: 179 days

Qualifications:

1. State Paraprofessional License from ISBE.

- 2. Current Teaching License, preferred; not required.
- 3. Awareness and ability to work with a group of students with varied disabilities rather than a single disability.
- 4. Ability to work collaboratively and problem solve.
- 5. Such alternatives to the above qualifications as the Board may find appropriate and acceptable.
- 6. CPI certification or willingness to be trained.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Assist with classroom activities under the direction of the general education or special education teacher.
- 2. Work with individuals or small groups at the teacher's request to review, reinforce, enrich and/or expand skills and concepts presented.
- 3. Collaborate with the general education and special education teacher regarding children's progress, interest levels, or problem areas.
- 4. Assist with the behavior management system under the direction of the general education and special education teacher.
- 5. Assist with daily charting of progress on academic and behavioral charts relevant to students.
- 6. Utilize confidential and personal information concerning students and staff for professional purposes only, and in accordance with District regulations.
- 7. Participate in appropriate staff development programs.
- 8. Must be able to climb stairs and ambulate around all areas of building.
- 9. Assist with instructional modifications recommended by planning team.
- 10. Participate in multidisciplinary staffing if requested.
- 12. Provide support to students who require assistive technological needs for communication.
- 13. Provide individualized and small group instruction in special education and/or general education classroom. Be able to assist with data collection.
- 14. Perform supervision of lunch, and bus activities as assigned by the principal.
- 15. Other duties as assigned (i.e. attendance, parent phone calls, field trips, copying, grading papers).
